

Important Information

Combine the row letter and column number to get the cell name

Only catches with high or moderate amounts of river herring and/or shad outside of grids are shown with location determined by best estimate using tow locations

All catches within grids are displayed

Cell classifications determined by most recent catch

Numbers inside of a cell indicate the number of tows within the cell.

A single tow may occur in several cells.

The HIGH bycatch threshold reflects a rate at which river herring and shad catch limits will be reached before Atlantic herring catch limits.

 Low (less than 0.3% River Herring and Shad bycatch)

 Moderate (between 0.3% and 1%)

 High (above 1%)
